This quilt is made with 3 fabrics:

- Fabric A 13 squares
- Fabric B 12 squares
- Fabric C 10 squares

Any size square can be used to get the desired size.

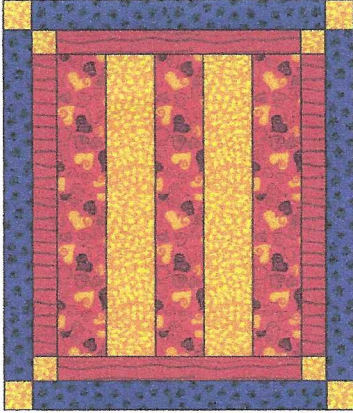

For 6 ½ inch squares use the following borders for a finished size 42" x 54"

- Inner border: less than ¼ yard fabric required
Cut 5 strips – 1 ½ inches x WOF
- Outer border – you will need less than ¾ yards of fabric
Cut 5 strips – 5 inches x WOF

CUTTING

1. Cut 5 - 5 1/2" by 31 1/2" strips for center.
2. Cut 4 - 3" strips for inner border.
3. Cut 4 - 3" by 3" squares for cornerstones of inner border.
4. Cut 4 - 3 1/2" strips for outer border.
5. Cut 4 - 3 1/2" by 3 1/2" squares for cornerstone of outer border.

SEWING

1. Sew the 5 center strips together using a 1/4" seam.
2. Sew a side strip of the inner border to each side of the center section.
3. Sew the 4 cornerstones to the top and bottom inner border strip.
4. Sew top and bottom inner border to the center section.
5. Repeat steps 2, 3, 4 for the outer border.

BABY BRICKS

35" X 39"

KIT CONTAINS:

16 Print Bricks. 4 ½" x 8 ½"

6 Print Bricks 4 ½" x 4 ½" "

8 Non- Print (White or Solid Bricks) 4 ½" x 8 ½"

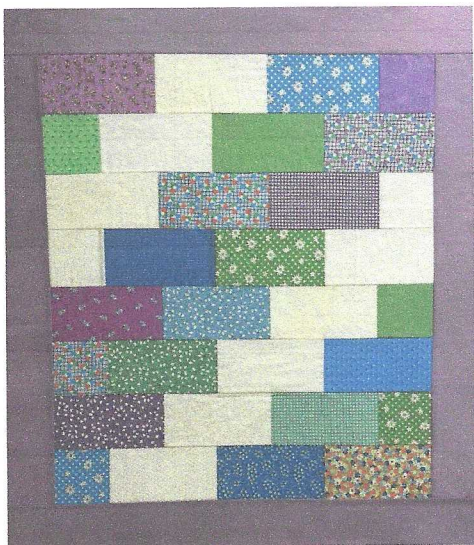
2 White or Neutral Bricks 4 ½" x 4 ½"

Outer Border – 4 WOF 4"

SEWING: Sew bricks together along the 4 ½" edge as shown in photo. Rows will contain 3 whole bricks and one 4 ½" x 4 ½" brick. Note: Every other row ends or begins with a 4 ½" x 4 ½" brick. Insert Non – Print (White or Solid) Bricks in locations shown in photo to create stair step look. Make 8 rows. Sew rows together as shown in photo to complete body of quilt.

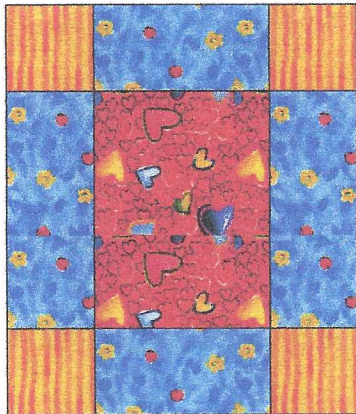
Add 4" outer border along vertical sides of quilt body. Add 4" outer border along top and bottom of quilt body.

QUILTING SUGGESTION: Channel quilt. Lengthen stitch length to 3.0 or 3.5. Stitch all in one direction, starting on the same side of the quilt for each row. This will eliminate puckering between rows. Using serpentine or straight line stitch, stitch along the seam lines. Next stitch in the middle of the brick rows using the same stitch. Using the same stitch, stitch a row in the middle of the borders.

MATERIAL - 2 or 3 yards of Coordinating Material.

CUTTING

1. Fold each yard in quarters. This should be 18" by 21" when folded.
2. Mark the center folded area. **DO NOT CUT THIS.**
3. From outside edges, made two cuts 9" each.

You will now have:

A center section measuring 18" by 24".

A top and bottom sash measuring 9" by 18" each.

Two side sections measuring 9" by 24".

Four corner stones measuring 9" by 9".

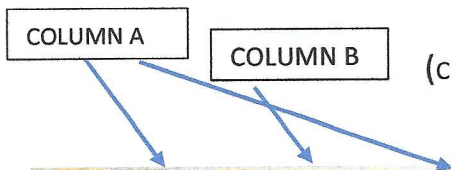
Repeat for each yard of material.

SEWING

Depending on how many yards you used, you will now mix and match your fabrics.

1. Sew the two side sections to the inner rectangle.
2. Sew the corner stones to the top and bottom sashing pieces.
3. Sew the top sashing strip with the corner stones to the center section.
4. Repeat step 3 for the bottom sashing strip.

CHARMING STRIPES BABY SIZE



(Created with Cheryl Brickey's Permission for Charity Use)

Overall Size: 35 1/2" x 41"

Fabric Requirements:

29 – 5" x 5" Squares

Cut 10 squares in half to make 20 rectangles 2 1/2" x 5"

Trim 2 squares to 3 3/4" x 5" (top and bottom of center column)

The remaining 17 squares will be used as 5" x 5" squares

Sashing for Pieced Columns

1/3 yard cut to:

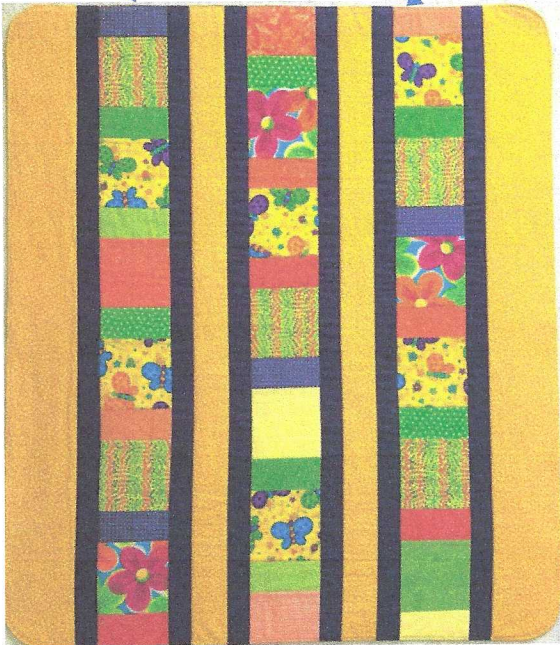
6 – 2" WOF strips

Background

3/4 yard cut to:

2 – 4 1/2" WOF strips – Outer Strips

2 – 3" WOF strips – Inner Strips



Piecing and Preparing the Columns

Use scant 1/4" seams throughout construction of quilt top. Press seams open or toward the 5" x 5" squares in the columns. Finished columns will be 5" x 41 1/2".

COLUMN A

1. Sew together the following, starting and ending with a 2 1/2" x 5" rectangle, alternate with 5" x 5" blocks:
 - 6 – 5" x 5" squares
 - 7 – Fabric rectangles 2 1/2" x 5"
2. Repeat step 1 to make 2 of column A for the inner and outer pieced columns.

COLUMN B

Sew together the following in an alternating arrangement, starting and ending the column with a 3 3/4" x 5" fabric rectangle then alternating 5" x 5" blocks and 2 1/2" x 5" rectangles.

- 5 – 5" x 5" squares
- 2 – 3 3/4" x 5" fabric rectangles (top and bottom of column)
- 6 – 2 1/2" x 5" fabric rectangles

Attach column sashing strips to alternate sides of pieced columns

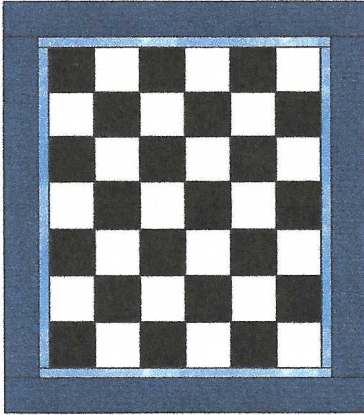
Attach 4 1/2" background strip to outer left-hand edge of the first Column A. Attach 4 1/2" outer background strip to right-hand edge of second Column A. **(Be sure sashings are sewn to pieced columns strips first.)**

Attach 3" background strips to right and left sides of Column B. Sew all pieces together to form quilt top.

IF USING DIRECTIONAL FABRIC BE SURE BLOCKS ARE ORIENTED IN THE SAME DIRECTION

Cutting

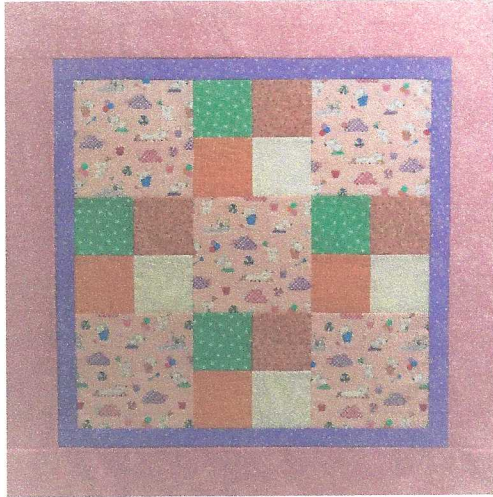
1. Cut 42- 5" squares. Can be 21 squares of 2 coordinating fabrics or various fabrics.
2. Cut 4 - 1 1/2" by WOF strips for inner border.
3. Cut 4 - 4" by WOF strips for outer border.

Sewing

1. Alternate light and dark 5" squares as shown above. Or if using various fabrics, choose a pleasing layout.
2. Sew 5" squares together using a 1/4" seam.
3. Sew 6 blocks across by 7 blocks down. Top should measure 27" X 31 1/2" without borders.
4. Sew a strip of the 1 1/2" inner border to each side of the pieced top.
5. Sew the last 2 - 1 1/2" strips of the inner border to the top and bottom.
6. Repeat steps 4. and 5. for the 4" outer border. Completed top should measure 36" X 40 1/2".

COLLEEN'S QUILT

(Dimensions are in inches: Horizontal then Vertical)



Overall Size: 38" x 38"

Borders: 2

Yardage: 5/8 yd Large Print Focus Fabric for Corners and Center Block

1/4 yd of 4 fabrics that coordinate with the focus fabric 4 patch blocks

1/4 yd for inner border

5/8 yd for outside border

(Fat Quarters can be used. Entire quilt can be made scrappy.)

Border 1: 1.5" on all sides

Border 2: 4" on all sides

CUTTING:

1. Cut 5 – 9.5" squares for corner and center blocks
2. Cut 4 – 5" squares of 4 different fabrics to make up 4 Four Patch Blocks
3. Cut 4 – 2" strips for the inner border
4. Cut 4 – 4.5" strips for the outer border

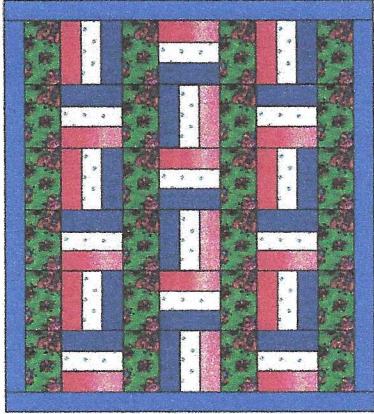
SEWING:

IF USING DIRECTIONAL FABRIC BE SURE BLOCKS ARE ORIENTED IN THE SAME DIRECTION

1. Sew 4 – 5" squares together to make 4 Four Patch Blocks. Place fabrics in same layout for all 4 Four Patch Blocks
2. Assemble 9.5" squares and Four Patch Blocks into three rows. Sew blocks together
3. Sew three rows together to assemble center of quilt. Press seams toward the 9.5" large blocks. This will make it easy to nest your seams as you sew the rows together.
4. Square up center of quilt to be approximately 27.5" x 27.5"
5. Add 2" inner border strips to opposite sides of quilt top
6. Add 2" inner border strips to the other opposite sides of quilt (top and bottom)
7. Repeat steps 5 and 6 for the outer border

CUTTING

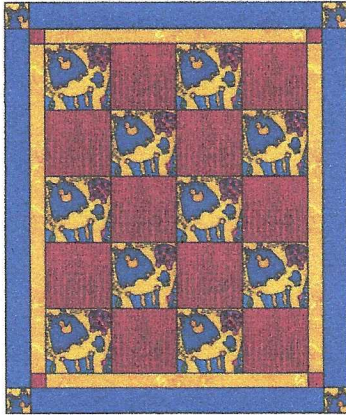
1. Cut 3 - 2 1/2" by 42" strips of 3 different fabrics.
2. Cut 4 - 4" by 36 1/2" strips of focus fabric for sashing. DO NOT CUT INTO BLOCKS.
3. Cut 4 - 2 1/2" strips for the border.

SEWING

1. Join the three 2 1/2" by 42" strip into strip sets. Strips should measure 6 1/2".
2. Subcut the strip sets into 18 - 6 1/2" blocks.
3. Layout the strip set blocks into rows as shown above. Watch the placement of the blocks!
4. Sew the focus fabric strips to the strip set rows as shown.
5. Sew 2 - 2 1/2" border strips to each side of the quilt, then add the remaining strips to the top and bottom.

CUTTING

1. Cut 2 - 7" by WOF strips from 2 coordinating focus fabrics.
2. Cut 10 - 7" squares from each fabric.
3. Cut 4 - 2" by WOF strips for inner border.
4. Cut 4 - 2" squares for cornerstones of the inner border from the leftovers of one of the focus fabrics.
5. Cut 4 - 3" by WOF for outer border.
6. Cut 4 - 3" squares for the cornerstones of the outer border from the leftovers of one of the other focus fabric.

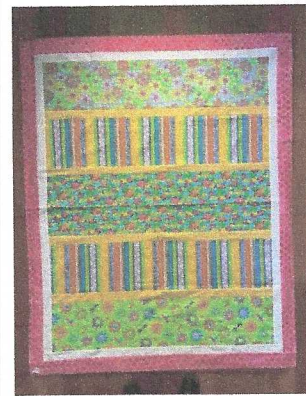
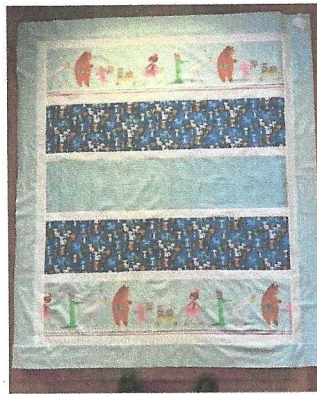
SEWING

1. Sew squares together as shown above using 1/4" seam.
2. Sew a strip of the inner border to each side of the pieced center section.
3. Sew the 4 corner to the top and bottom inner border strips.
4. Sew top and bottom inner borders to the pieced center section.
5. Repeat steps 2, 3, 4 for the outer border.

Row by Row Quilts

Supplies

- Five 9 inch by WOF strips
- Four 2 inch by WOF strips for sashing
- Five 2 inch by WOF strips for inner border
- Six 3 or 4 inch by WOF strips for outer border. Some quilts contain four strips that will not need to be pieced.



Instructions

- Create the quilt interior.
 - **Remove the selvage from all the strips before you begin.**
 - Carefully lay out the five 9 inch strips and the 4 interior sashing strips taking care to keep directional fabrics aligned.
 - **Align all strips on the left hand side.** Sew each sashing to the strip above it.
 - Sew strip 1 to strip2, strip 3 to strip 4
 - Now sew the strips together to make the interior of the quilt.
 - Press well. Each seam should be pressed carefully from both the front and the back.
- Square up the quilt.
 - Fold the quilt so the edges of the top strip align with the edges of the bottom strip and the quilt folds smoothly.
 - Trim both sides of the quilt at a right angle to the fold.
- Add the borders.
 - General border guidelines
 - Always measure the quilt top in 3 places before cutting borders. Use the average of the three measurements.
 - Cut the borders for both sides at the same time to insure they are the same length.
 - Pin each border near each end and in the middle. Then add extra pins easing in any fullness.
 - Press the seam toward the border.
 - Add the 2 inch inner border.
 - Add the 3 or 4 inch outer border. Many quilts contain border strips that are long enough that they will not need to be pieced, so check before you piece them.

Once the top is complete, give it a final pressing. Check the back of the quilt to be sure the seams do not flip.

Measure the top and write your name along with the measurements on a slip of paper and pin it to the top along with the binding if it was included.

Sally's Simply Charming Quilt – Baby Size

34" x 41"



SUPPLIES:

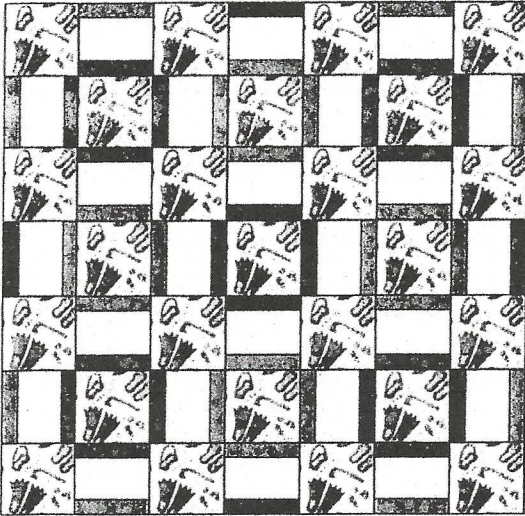
- 24 – 5" Squares
- Background Fabric – 3 – 5" strips WOF sub-cut to:
24 – 3" x 5" rectangles
24 – 2" x 5" rectangles
- Borders – 1 ½" Inner Border (4 strips WOF)
3" Outer Border (4 strips WOF)

Blocks are constructed by adding a 2" strip to one side and a 3" strip to the opposite side of the 5" square. Completed blocks are now 5" x 9".

Combine 6 blocks to make a row, alternating the position of the 2" and 3" strips sewn to the blocks from top to bottom. **WATCH FOR ANY DIRECTIONAL FABRICS.** Construct 4 rows. Sew the 4 rows together. Add the 1 ½" inner border to longest sides then across the top and bottom. Add the 3" outer border in the same manner.

CUTTING

1. Cut 4 - 2" by 42" strips of 2 different fabrics for strip set..
2. Cut 4 - 3" by 42" strips for center of strip set.
3. Cut 4 - 6" by 42" strips of focus fabrics. Need 25 - 6" by 6" squares.

SEWING

1. Join a 2" strip to either side of a 3" center fabric to make 4 strip sets. Strips should measure 6".
2. Subcut strip sets into 6" by 6" segments. Need 24 segments.
3. Layout strip set segments and focus fabric as shown above.
4. Remember to alternate each row of strip set blocks. First row should be horizontal, second row should be vertical, and so on.
