

JUNE - AIR CASTLE

Light fabric Piece A cut 1 square at $5 \frac{1}{4}$ inches, cut twice on the diagonal. Should have 4 triangles.
 Piece B cut 4 squares at $4 \frac{7}{8}$ inches, cut once on the diagonal. Should have 8 triangles.
 Piece C cut 1 square at $4 \frac{1}{2}$ inches. Please note you can make this piece a 3rd color.

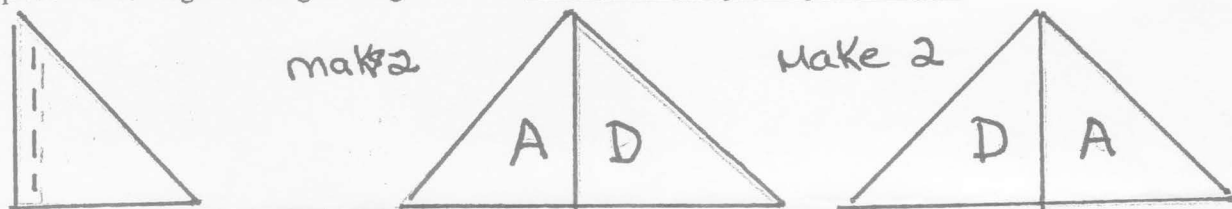
Dark fabric Piece D cut 1 square at $5 \frac{1}{4}$ inches, cut twice on the diagonal. You should have 4 triangles.
 Piece E cut 2 squares at $4 \frac{7}{8}$ inches, cut once on diagonal. You should have 4 triangles.
 Piece F cut 4 squares at $2 \frac{1}{2}$ inches.

SEWING

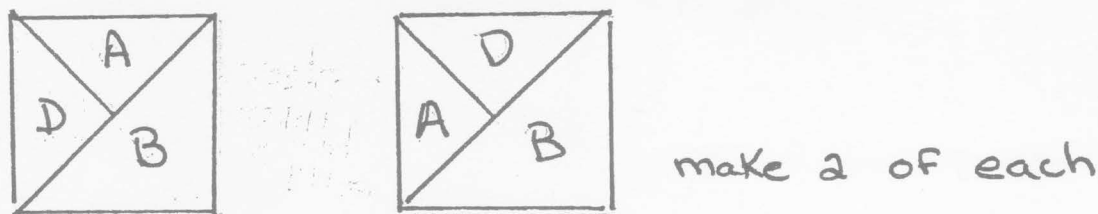
Place piece B and E together and sew to make a half square triangle.



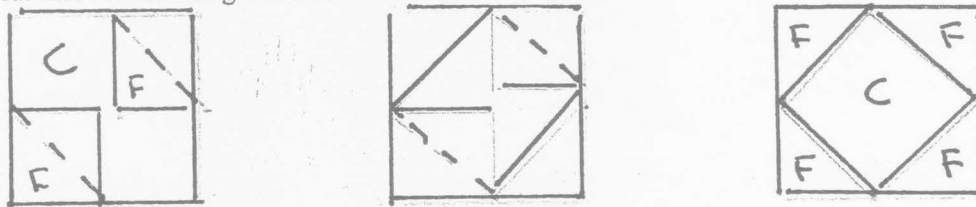
Sew piece A and D together using the diagram below. We are not making half square triangles.



Sew the A D unit to a B piece using the diagram for placement. You will make 2 one way and 2 another way.



To make the center we are going to place piece F on 2 corner of piece C and sew a diagonal line. See diagram. Cut away the extra leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam allowance. Repeat with the remaining 2 corners.



Sew the block together using the layout below.
