
Maxi's Flowergarden Quilt




English Flower Garden

You will need 140 squares of fabric for your quilt. If you decide to have sashing for your quilt, you need to apply it between all the squares and on **two of the edges** (e.g. the left side and the top).

You can double the width and the length, 20 wide by 28 high using 560 squares.


Begin by making a top 10 squares wide and 14 squares deep. See the diagrams below.

If you want to have sashing between you squares, sashing should go between each square. On the outside, sashing should only go on one side and either on the top or the bottom. See the picture below.






Now, starting at the bottom of the left side, cut on the diagonal through each square until you reach the other side 4 squares from the top. Move this piece away slightly. Now begin at the top left corner cutting on the diagonal until you reach the first cut line. See the diagrams below.





Now rearrange the pieces, all the outside labeled sides will go to the inside, all the diagonal cuts go to the outside.







Assemble the pieces and add borders if desired. Since all the outside edges are on the bias, be sure to measure the quilt through the center to determine the length for the side borders. Once these borders are added, measure the width through the center for the length of the top and bottom borders.
